PROPHETS, PRIESTS, AND KINGS

ISRAEL ASKED FOR A KING so she could be like other nations (1 Sam. 8:6). God grants her request but sets lines of authority between prophet, priest, and king to provide checks and balances for the monarchy. All three rule under God's authority. Each entity has its own privileges and responsibilities and is to respect the authority of the others. All are to exercise their power with humility since they answer to God. Though Israel will have an earthly king, the king and the people are to remember that God is sovereign.
