

THE DIVIDED KINGDOM

TRIBES	KINGDOM SPLITS 930 BC	DEFEATED AND EXILED	39 KINGS *	FATE
Israel Northern Kingdom (10 tribes)	Lasts 210 years	722 BC to Assyria	19 Kings 0 Godly	Mostly absorbed by the nations where they were deported. Some return to Jerusalem when the Babylonian captives return.
Judah Southern Kingdom (2 tribes) <i>Judah, Benjamin</i>	Lasts 333 years	Three phases of deportation to Babylon: around 607, 597, and 586 BC	20 Kings 8 Godly	Remnant returns to the land. Under the leadership of Zerubbabel, Ezra, and Nehemiah, the Jews rebuild Jerusalem and the temple.

* After the split, the northern kingdom (Israel) had 19 kings and the southern kingdom (Judah) had 20. A total of 39 kings reigned during the divided kingdom. Add the four kings of the united kingdom prior to the split (Saul, Ishbosheth, David and Solomon), and 43 kings ruled over God's people from the beginning to the end of the monarchy.
