| <div>JUDAH</div> <div>The Divided Kingdom of Judah (930-586 BC)</div> <div><div>1. Survives 344 years.</div><div>2. Has 20 rulers, 8 godly.</div><div>3. All but one ruler (Athalia) of David's dynasty.</div><div>4. One turnover of government (Athalia).</div><div>5. Has 7 violent deaths of rulers in 344 years.</div></div>                                       | <div>ISRAEL</div> <div>The Divided Kingdom of Israel (930-720 BC)</div> <div><div>1. Survives 210 years.</div><div>2. Has 19 kings, none godly.</div><div>3. Has 5 different dynasties.</div><div>4. Has 9 changes of power.</div><div>5. Has 9 violent deaths of ruler in 210 years.</div></div> |
| <div>JUDAH AND UNITED KINGDOM</div> <div>Combined</div> <div>(1050?-586 BC)</div> <div><div>1. Exists over 450 years.</div><div>2. Has 24 kings, 10 godly.</div><div>3. All but 3 rulers of David's dynasty (Saul, Ishbosheth, Athaliah).</div><div>4. Has only 2 regime changes (Saul, Athaliah).</div><div>5. Has 9 violent deaths of ruler in 434 years.</div></div> | <div>JUDAH OUTLASTS ISRAEL</div> <div>Judah survives 134 years longer than Israel.</div> <div><div>Israel Falls720 BC</div><div>Judah Falls- 586 BC</div><div>134 Years</div></div>                                                                                                               |
